APPROPRIATE SYMPTOMS/CONCERNS

- Cold and Flu symptoms
- Sore Throat
- Ear pain
- STD Concerns
- Urinary Tract Infections
- Nausea, Vomiting, or Diarrhea
- Abdominal Pain
- Headache/Migraine
- Dizziness
- Rash or skin concerns
- Acute Injuries
- Stye/Red eyes/Pink eye

REQUIRES

- Chronic injuries/conditions
 (i.e. Low Back pain for 6 months)
- Diagnostic Imaging Follow Up
- Specialty Care Follow Up
- Medication Refills/Problems
- Multiple Concerns
- Administrative Concerns (i.e. Light Duty)

Active Duty Service Members presenting with other symptoms can be booked into a future appointment.
