

Naval Hospital Bremerton Opens Enrollment Opportunities

Naval Hospital Bremerton has recently opened enrollment to those Active Duty Family Members, Retirees and Retiree Family Members who are under age 65 and reside in our Prime Service Area. While enrolled at Naval Hospital Bremerton, you will be enrolled in TRICARE Prime.

How to Change Your Enrollment / Primary Care Manager

If you are currently enrolled in TRICARE Prime, you can change your enrollment to Naval Hospital Bremerton by using one of the following options:

- ➤ By Telephone: Call HealthNet Federal Services at 1-844-866-WEST (9378), Monday through Friday, 5:00 a.m.—9:00 p.m. (PT) to transfer your enrollment to Naval Hospital Bremerton and select your Primary Care Manager at Naval Hospital Bremerton
- ➤ Online: Visit Beneficiary Web Enrollment site at https://milconnect.dmdc.osd.mil/milconnect/ Once there, "View my Healthcare Coverage" and log in using CAC or DS Logon. From there you can change your primary care manager to Naval Hospital Bremerton, see your current coverage, etc.
- Mailing/Fax: Print, complete and mail this form (www.tricare-west.com/content/hnfs/home/tw/bene/res/bene_forms/enrollment/application_pcm_change.html) to Health Net Federal Services, LLC for processing

Beneficiaries who remain eligible will be automatically re-enrolled in TRICARE Prime and assigned to Naval Hospital Bremerton each year unless selecting a different primary care manager elsewhere, or electing a different TRICARE option (or disenrollment) during the open enrollment season.

If currently enrolled in TRICARE Select, changes in enrollment can only be made during TRICARE's Open Season (see https://tricare.mil/openseason) or within 90 days of a qualifying life event (https://tricare.mil/LifeEvents/QLE). When enrolling during the TRICARE Open Season, TRICARE Prime enrollment is effective January 1 of the following year. However, enrollment due to a qualifying life event (QLE), such as adding a newborn, will be effective the date of the QLE event.





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
