

## Limited Duty (LIMDU): What You Need to Know



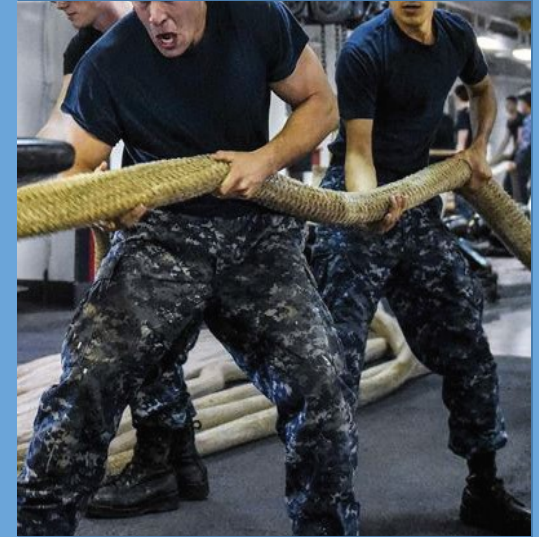
### LIGHT DUTY

- ◆ Approved in 30 day increments
- ◆ Cannot exceed 90 days
- ◆ Still considered **deployable**
- ◆ Expected to return to duty (RTD) **within 90 days**



### LIMITED DUTY

- ◆ Duty status assigned only by a Medical Evaluation Board
- ◆ Two types: Temporary or Permanent
- ◆ Considered **non-deployable**



### TYPES OF LIMDU

- ◆ Temporary LIMDU anticipates RTD **within 364 days** unless extended by PERS-454
- ◆ Permanent LIMDU (PLD) only assigned by PEB via PERS-454 at member's request.
- ◆ PLD stationed near medical care

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

- ◆ Service members **MUST** attend all scheduled medical appointments and coordinate with medical staff via their unit's **Deployability Coordinator**. Personal accountability and duty assignments of LIMDU personnel remains with their assigned units.
